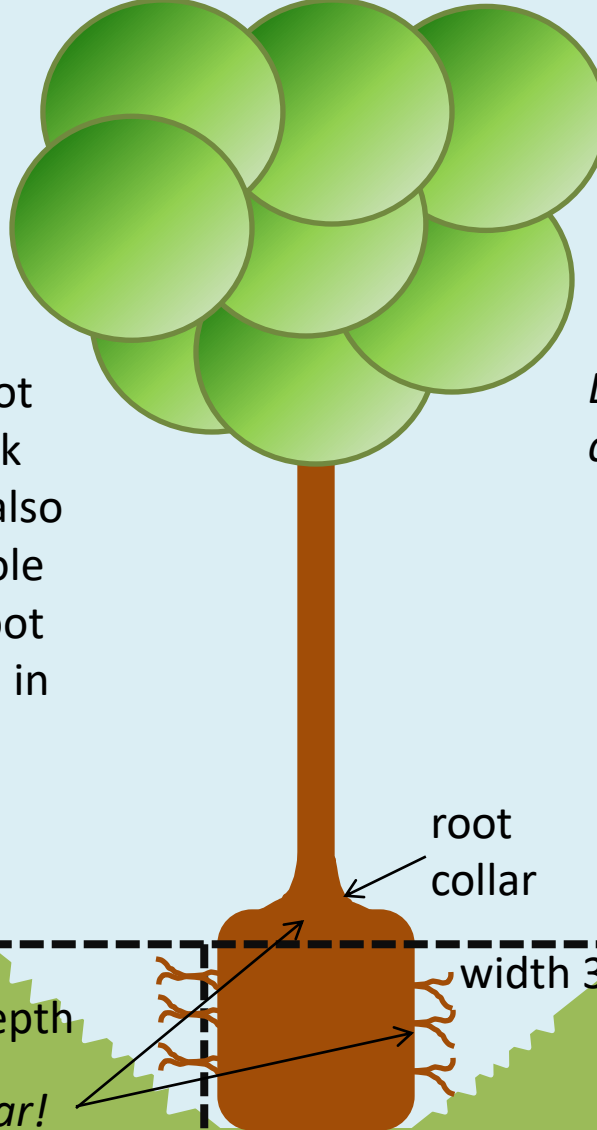


How to Plant a Tree

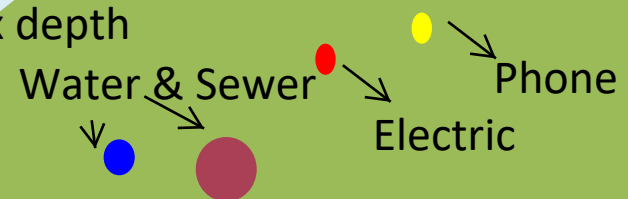
After removing your tree from the container, look for the "root collar," the bottom of the trunk where the roots start. This is also called the "root flair." Dig a hole to match the height from the root collar to the bottom of the soil in the container and three times wider.



Do you know where your electric cable is? **Don't be shocked!**

Use a tarp to hold the soil for easy cleanup after refilling the hole.



**It is critical to find the root collar!
Dig down in the container till you see roots. Also, prune/cut any circular roots growing around the wall of the container.*
